

Long Live solidarity of the working class

The first of May is on its way and it is the day of celebration and solidarity of our class across the world as a class in a struggle against oppression and exploitation. It is the day of our unity for freedom of the millions of people suffering every day from exploitation, poverty, hunger and humiliation. Today the most "liberal" and "democrat" bourgeois governments are more cruel, savage and ruthless than the most far right factions at the beginning of the twentieth century.

At the same time, in no period in time has the world been so ready for making a society with equality and welfare. Presently, the huge capitals that the working class has created and the means to access every material and non-material needs, can certainly maintain a pleasant and convenient life for every human being, and transform the world to a real paradise on this earth. The key to this transformation is with the working class. The world has for years been ready for the socialist revolution. It is the working class that is not ready in huge numbers for this transformation. It is the working class that, despite the reduction of its share of the total that it has produced, is still captivated and deceived by the bourgeoisie ideologies. The bourgeoisie is able to produce and reproduce the reactionary ideologies within the working class and deprive the working class consciousness of the possibility of the socialist revolution by not only its prisons, police, terror and the monopoly of the subservient media empire that has been created with the labour of the working class, but also through the brain-washing machinery of religion and superstition, enforcement of poverty and deprivation and enflaming all sorts of nationality, tribal or religion feuds.

Across the globe, in addition to incarceration, execution, terror, threatening and firing of the worker's activists and leaders, bourgeoisie tries to hide the reality of the working class interests, their common international destiny and the conflict of their class interest against the bourgeois class. Bourgeoisie tries to show that any attempt to unite the working class to end capitalism, establish the communist society and the ideals and dreams of generations of the working class, is impossible and is only an illusion. This is their biggest means for the continuation of the rule of capital and the obstacle in the path of freedom of the workers across the world.

Today, the Iranian bourgeoisie and their "moderate" government, with the help of many bourgeois intellectuals and parties and the extensive means available to them, are trying to present their interests, their political manoeuvres in providing higher profitability of capital, as an improvement in the conditions of the working class.
